

# **GFK** Interface

With the GFK Interface, sales data from TireMaster is sent to the market research organization GFK. Submitted sales data includes parts, labor, services (such as state inspections) add-ons, shop supplies, and VINs. This document includes the following sections:

### **Requirements**

To use the GFK Interface, you need the following:

- TireMaster 8.9.0 or TireMaster Point of Sale 3.8.9 (or a newer version of either product) installed on your TireMaster server
- An Internet connection for your TireMaster server

# Installing the GFK Interface

When you install the GFK Interface, run the installation on your TireMaster server only.

### Accessing an Automatically-Deployed Installer

If your TireMaster system is set up to download automatically-deployed installers as part of the nightly backup process, the GFK installer is already available to you. Typically, installers are placed in one of the following locations:

- c:\TireMaster\apps
  - c:\TMPOS\apps
- d:\QDSTM\apps

d:\TireMaster\apps

d:\TMPOS\apps

c:\QDSTM\apps

**Note:** If your installers are downloaded to a different location, navigate to that folder instead.

#### To access automatically-deployed installers

- 1. On the desktop of your TireMaster server, double-click **My Computer**. The My Computer screen appears.
- 2. Double-click the letter or icon for the drive in which TireMaster is installed. (Usually, it's the c: or d: drive.)
- 3. Double-click the TireMaster program folder (usually c:\qdstm, d:\qdstm, c:\tiremaster, d:\tiremaster, c:\tmpos, or d:\tmpos).
- 4. Double-click the apps folder, and locate the file GFK0000000-01000000.exe.

Once you've located the GFK installer, complete the installation. For instructions, see "Completing the GFK Installation" on page 2.

### Downloading the GFK Installer

The GFK installer is available for download from the TireMaster Support site. When you download the installer, save it your TireMaster server.

#### To download the GFK Installer

- 1. Log on to http://support.tiremaster.com.
- 2. On the menu, click **Download Programs**. The Download Center page appears.
- **3.** Click the link for the GFK installer. Depending on your browser, you'll be prompted to save or run the file.
- 4. Select the location where you want to save the installer, and click Save.
- 5. When the download is complete, click **Close**.
- 6. Exit the TireMaster Support site.

Once you have finished downloading the installer, you can install GFK. For instructions, see "Completing the GFK Installation" on page 2.

### **Completing the GFK Installation**

After you've located or downloaded the GFK installer, you can complete the installation.

#### To complete the GFK installation

- 1. Close all applications on your computer, including those in the system tray.
- **2.** Do one of the following:
  - Go to the **apps** directory in the **TireMaster** program folder. For more information, see "Accessing an Automatically-Deployed Installer" on page 1.
  - Go to the directory where you saved the installers that you downloaded from the TireMaster Support site.
- 3. Double-click GFK0000000-01000000.exe. The TireMaster Installation Program screen appears.
- 4. Click OK. The Search Results screen appears.
- 5. Select the location in which you want to install the interface (usually c:\qdstm, d:\qdstm, c:\tiremaster, c:\tiremaster, c:\tiremaster, or d:\tiremaster), and click Install.
- 6. At the end of the installation, click Finish.

# Setting Up the GFK Interface

Setting up GFK includes establishing your GFK credentials and defining the address of FTP site to which your data will be sent. The credentials and FTP location are provided to you by GFK.

#### To set up the GFK Interface

- 1. In TireMaster, select Interface Setups from the Interfaces menu. The Interface Setup screen appears.
- 2. Click GFK Interface. The GFK Setup screen appears.
- 3. Type the user name, password, and FTP location provided by GFK.

- 4. To save your changes, click OK.
- 5. Close the Interface Setup screen.

# **Running the GFK Interface**

Data from TireMaster is sent to GFK during an automated process that occurs every Monday at 2:00 AM. To ensure successful transmission, make sure your TireMaster server is turned on at that time.

**Note:** The data sent during the first transmission will include transactions dating back to the beginning of 2014.
